Allan Melville CHAPIN

Allan Melville Chapin was born in Boston, Massachusetts

He graduated from Yale University in 1964 (B.A., Honors with Exceptional Distinction) and Yale Law School in 1968 (LLB, Member of Law Journal).

In September 1968, he joined the law firm of Sullivan, where he became a partner in October 1976. Mr. Chapin was a resident of the Paris office of Sullivan & Cromwell for several years. He speaks, reads and writes French fluently. He was in charge of the Sullivan & Cromwell European operations and as such traveled extensively to their Paris and London offices. In January 2000, Mr. Chapin joined Lazard Freres & Co. LLC as a Managing Director. In 2002, Mr. Chapin left Lazard and became a Managing Director of Compass Advisers, LLP., a boutique investment advisory firm.

During his almost 40 years of investment banking and corporate legal practice, Mr. Chapin has acted for sovereign governments, agencies, investment and merchant banks, insurance companies, a wide array of industrial private sector companies, and many foreign investors, both individuals and corporations. Among others, he has represented Régie Nationale des Usines Renault S.A. and its subsidiaries American Motors Corporation, Renault Véhicules Industriels S.A. and Mack Trucks, Inc., and he served on the Boards of American Motors Corporation and Mack Trucks, Inc. He also represented SCOR S.A. and its subsidiary SCOR U.S. Corporation where he serves on the Boards of both. In the past he has also acted for Marine Wendel, Total Elf, Crédit Lyonnais, Suez, Lazard (before he became a partner of that firm), and Inbev S.A.

Mr. Chapin is also Chairman of the American Friends of the Claude Pompidou Foundation and is a Chairman, Director and Member of the Executive Committee of the French-American Foundation.

Mr. Chapin is a director of PPR, SCOR, SCOR U.S. Corporation and a former director of InBev, CIFG, American Motors Corporation and Mack Trucks. Mr. Chapin served in the United State Marine Corps from 1961 to 1967. He has five children, Samuel, Jessica, Amanda, Anthony and Peter.
