Alfred J. Ross

He is a retired partner and Of Counsel of Shearman & Sterling in New York where he practiced international law for more than forty years. He was a senior member of the firm's Mergers & Acquisitions Practice Group and represented a number of major multinational companies in connection with acquisitions in the United States, Europe and Latin America. He also represented clients in connection with international joint ventures and investments in the United States and advised on international arbitration matters and corporate governance.

During the period 1976 through 1983, Mr. Ross advised the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia in connection with its industrial development projects in Jubail and Yanbu. He was based in the Algiers and Paris offices of Shearman & Sterling from 1966 to 1969 and was Managing Partner of the Paris office from 1977 to 1985. He joined the firm in 1963, became a partner in 1972 and was Of Counsel in 2004 and 2005.

Mr. Ross was a Visiting Professor at the Ecole Supérieure de Commerce de Bordeaux from 2004 – 2006 where he taught courses on International Contracts and International Commercial Transactions. He currently teaches a course at the Institut D'Etudes Politiques (Sciences Po) in Paris on Basic Principles of American Law.

Mr. Ross is a Director and member of the Executive Committee of the French-American Foundation, Vice Chairman and a Director of Big Brothers Big Sisters International, formerly, a Director of AIESEC-US, and a Member of the Harvard Overseers Committee on University Resources.

Mr. Ross received a B.A. from Georgetown College in 1960, attended the University of Fribourg (Switz.) in 1958-1959, and received a J.D. from Harvard Law School in 1963
