**Bertrand Badré**

Bertrand Badré is the Chief Financial Officer of Crédit Agricole S.A Group. He is also member of Crédit Agricole S.A. Group's Executive Committee.

Bertrand began his career in 1989 as Assistant Group Controller for BFI-Ibexa, a Franco-American company that sells professional electronic components. On graduating from ENA in 1995, he joined the French National Audit Office, with responsibility notably for the mission to reform the French Caisses d'Epargne (1997-1998), during which he gained valuable insight into the French banking sector. In 1999, he joined Banque Lazard, firstly in London for 18 months as Assistant Director of Corporate Finance, then in New York, as Vice-President, and later Director of Mergers and Acquisitions, specialising in financial institutions. In 2003, Bertrand Badré became part of the French President's diplomatic unit, alongside Michel Camdessus (former CEO of IMF). In this capacity, he was responsible for preparing the G8 summit in Evian and was spokesman of the working party on new international financial contributions (the Landau report). In 2004, he was appointed Managing Partner in the Financial Affairs department of Banque Lazard in Paris where he remained until July 2007.

Bertrand Badré is a graduate of HEC business school, of Sciences Po and of ENA, and holds a Masters degree in history (Sorbonne).
