Sarah de LENCQUESAING

Grew up in Venezuela, El Salvador, Mexico, Japan and the Philippines; pursued her undergraduate university studies in the US, Cornell University '80; joined Chemical Bank International Division and left a 7 year banking career with Chemical Bank, New York as associate vice-president for Latin America.

In 1987, Sarah de Lencquesaing married and moved to Paris, France. Three children later, after numerous activities in charitable and not for profit organizations synchronized with family life, Sarah de Lencquesaing was named to the Board of Trustees of the American Library in Paris (ALP) in 1998.

An eleven year contribution to the ALP oversaw the total re-structuring of this venerable institution starting with governance, and proceeding into the areas of finance and investments, operations and lastly, development. This was done as Head of the Governance Committee, Assistant Treasurer, Treasurer and finally, Vice-Chairman of the Board. Having established Trustee term limits as part of the governance retooling, Sarah de Lencquesaing was the first to reach term limits and to step down from the Board in June 2009, leaving an institution whose financial and operational indicators all show a vibrant, growing institution entering its second century with renewed strength. In addition, Sarah de Lencquesaing has maintained active involvement with the Cornell University alumni structures in Ithaca and Paris, as well as with local French cultural institutions in the North of France.
